Keeping safe online reminders

- Keep your privacy settings as secure as possible on all devices, apps and programmes that you use – if are unsure about what this means or how to do it please ask your parents/carers, or contact the ICT team at UKAT on the address above.
- Never give out your passwords for any of your devices, apps or programmes that you use.







- Please do not befriend people online that you don't know.
- DO NOT meet up with people you've met online. If someone suggests this to you, immediately tell your parent or carer.
- Remember that not everyone online is who they say they are.
- Think carefully about what you say before you post something online.
- Respect other people's views, even if you don't agree with someone else's views does not mean you need to be unkind or offensive.
- If you see something online that makes you feel uncomfortable, unsafe or worried: leave your device and go and tell your parent/carer or trusted adult immediately.

Please remember your safety and wellbeing is of prime importance to us - even though you are not in school. We are still here to support you.
