Dear Parent/Carer

You may be aware that the latest government pay offer for teachers has been rejected and the National Education Union (NEU) have planned an additional two days of strike action. These are due to take place on Wednesday 5th July 2023 and Friday 7th July 2023. Please note that Thursday 6th July 2023 is an INSET day where we welcome our new year 7 students to the Academy, therefore no current students will be on site.

**Years 7, 8 and 9 students** will be asked to remain at home on Wednesday 5th July 2023 and Friday 7th July 2023 and asked to study remotely. Teachers who are not striking will provide live online lessons which follow your child's timetable for these days. Lessons can be accessed via our online learning platform, Microsoft Teams.

Year 10 students who are attending the geography field trip on Wednesday 5th July 2023 to Herne Bay MUST attend for the trip. The trip forms part of the coursework study that is a compulsory element of the GCSE examination. Year 10 students who are not on the field trip will be asked to remain at home on Wednesday 5th July 2023 and Friday 7th July 2023 and asked to study remotely. Teachers who are not striking will provide live online lessons which follow your child's timetable for these days. Lessons can be accessed via our online learning platform, Microsoft Teams.

**Year 12** students will be required to attend the Academy on Wednesday 5th July 2023 and Friday 7th July 2023. Parents/carers will receive a separate letter detailing arrangements for these days.

If a live lesson is not available because a member of staff is striking, we have provided some links below for students to engage in independent study, revision or research into the topics they are studying.
