RE: Careers Programme

To ensure our students enjoy high quality career guidance and experiences, we have embedded a careers programme within all aspects of academy life. This programme is designed to provide students with a careers offer that will support them throughout their education and into their future career pathways.

Below there is a list of the range of experiences and support available for all year groups as well as a table with the tailored activities for year groups. All students have:

- Access to Unifrog, a complete destinations platform, a one-stop-shop for whole-school careers guidance. The aim is to provide the best opportunities, information, and guidance.
- A range of events are in place to help students gather information about pathways and providers e.g NHS staffed information stand leading to a career's clinic
- Local Labour Market information used to make informed decisions about future careers
- Outside speakers invited into the academy to discuss options or company visits and specific events to gather information
