I am writing to you with a few reminders about punctuality and uniform expectations for all students at Brompton Academy.

## Punctuality at the Academy

Thank you for your continued efforts in getting your child to the Academy on time to support their learning.

Please ensure that your child is on the Academy site before 8:20am; any students walking through the main entrance after 8:25am will be marked late and a detention will be set for 30 minutes.

## Uniform

Thank you to those of you who ensure your child is correctly dressed as per the uniform code each day. Please can we ask for your support in ensuring that your child has the correct full uniform and school shoes, in particular blazers and school trousers:

- Black plain business style straight fit or bootcut trousers and can be purchased from Uniformbase or any retailer. Please note, no tight, stretchy, shiny, flares, denim style material, jeggings, or skinny fit allowed.
- Blazer: to be worn at all times.
