Dear Parents / Carers

I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself and the SEN team working at Brompton Academy, including the Eliot Centre.

Within our SEN team, we embody our Academy aim to "Transform Lives Through Learning", our aim is to support all our young people and families to ensure the best possible support is always provided.

The SEN team in the academy comprises myself as SENCO and two assistant SENCOs: Mrs May and Miss Rose. Both Mrs May and Miss Rose have experience in a range of SEN settings including specialist provision, mainstream and the independent sector in Kent and Medway. The team is supported by our Speech and Language Therapists, Mrs Howard, and Mrs Harvey, who work closely with many of our students.

As a team, we recognise that communication between home and school is key to ensuring we provide the best for the young people in our care. Therefore, I am writing to highlight communication methods which will allow you to contact us directly.

SEN Single Point of Access (SPA)

Parents Evenings

On each of these evenings, there will also be a member of the SEN team available throughout the evening should you wish to discuss any concerns you may have. Appointments are not necessary on these evenings please drop by and speak to us.







SEN Clinics

New for 2024, Brompton Academy have been holding a termly SEN clinic (dates listed below for the remainder of this academic year). These clinics are an opportunity to meet one of the SEN team in a 30-minute window to discuss any concerns or worries you might have or to share information. The appointments will be bookable in advance allowing us to also gather some information from classroom teachers in advance of the clinic meeting.

How to book clinics

Appointments for our SEN Clinics will open 3 weeks before each event and close at midday on the Friday before the clinic.

All appointments are to be booked online through SchoolCloud, instructions on how to do this are below. Appointments for these clinics are limited therefore booking early is advisable.

To access School Cloud, you will need to visit https://bromptonacademy.schoolcloud.co.uk/ to complete your details and student details sections, along with booking appointments. The School Cloud system is accessible on any internet enabled electronic device, including mobile phones. Once completed, this will authenticate your account via the Academy system.

Please be aware that when logging in to School Cloud, your details must match the Academy's details, including your name. Please do not use shortened versions of names as the system will not allow you access. Also, if you have more than one child at the Academy, you will need to create a separate account for each child.
