## Careers Guidance

Despite online learning we have continued to ensure that all students have the correct information, advice and guidance required for them to choose their next steps carefully. Year 12's have recently finished a Careers Programme delivered by the University of Kent Ambassadors, and next term they will start the University and Apprenticeships process to ensure they are fully prepared. All students should be attending any Teams meetings with their PPD or Personal Tutor as this is often when these sessions are delivered.

Year 13 have just finished their UCAS applications, and we are really pleased to announce that despite the huge difficulties they have had since the start of their Sixth Form Studies, we have a record number of applications to University and to Medical, Veterinary and Dental courses and also applications to Oxford and Cambridge.
