### **Queen's Platinum Jubilee Celebrations**

In recognition of this outstanding achievement, Woolf Mini School are hosting a 'street stall' event and activities, this consists of fun activities for students to participate in and lots of items for sale to raise money for charity. The Refectory at the Academy is also being decorated in red, white and blue ribbons and there will be jubilee cupcakes on sale. In addition to all of this, we will have an ice cream van on site and all students will receive a free ice cream. These activities will be taking place on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May 2022.

### **Uniform**

From the start of Term 6 if the weather is hot, students will not be required to wear their blazers, but need to ensure that they wear the rest of their Academy uniform. We also require all students to come fully prepared for their PE lesson with their full kit. PE full kit includes:

## End of Year Assessments

**Year 7-9** - Your child will be sitting end of year assessments in the week beginning the 13<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> June 2022. These assessments take place annually for all year groups and will be in class, with their usual teacher in timed conditions. These assessments are more substantial than the Term 2 and Term 4 assessments as they are a culmination of all learning covered throughout this year. Your child's grades will be shared in their end of year report.

To support your child with these assessments, their Personal Tutor will share some revision strategies this week to develop good revision habits. Your child's class teacher will also provide advice and guidance on the subject content to revise.

**Year 10** – Students will be sitting 'mini mock exams' from the 29<sup>th</sup> to the 6<sup>th</sup> July 2022. These exams are a shortened version of the exams they will sit in Year 11 but will be completed in the Sports Hall under exam conditions.

## Key Dates for Term 6

**Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> July 2022** – Is our first Mini School Reward Day. Our Mini School system is now reaching its first full academic year and there are a lot of successes to celebrate. To end this academic year, we will be rewarding the Mini School with the most REACH points with a range of different activities, these include the opportunity to go to the ice rink, bowling, laser tag, the cinema and some activities at the Academy.

This reward day will be given to students in the winning Mini School (Years 7 – 10). There are around 200 students which includes 50 students from each year group) - the current leaders are Woolf Mini School!

There is also a big raffle prize with a value of up to £300 which students could enter with their ePraise points.

**23<sup>rd</sup> June 2022** – Year 11 Prom night at the St. George Hotel in Chatham. This is the first time this event has taken place in two years, and I know both staff and students are really looking forward to this event.
