Locker Keys

The majority of students had the opportunity to empty their locker and return the key in order to collect their deposits back on Friday. If you child still needs to return their locker key, they will need to go to the Community office this week.

One-to-One Meetings

Our Careers Manager, Mrs Murphy, is available this week to meet with students if they would like any information or guidance to support with their next steps. Your child should email sharonmurphy@universityofkentacademiestrust.org.uk if they would like to arrange a one-to-one meeting.

BTEC Coursework

BTEC subject lessons are focused on providing students with time to complete their final coursework assignments. Students will be informed once they have completed their course and qualifications. If your child still has some of their coursework outstanding, they will need to continue to attend their BTEC lessons after May half term. Their BTEC teacher will contact you to confirm the days and times to attend in order to complete this.

Additional Evidence

At the start of Term 6, Teachers, Subject Leaders and members of the Senior Leadership Team will be involved in the process to derive and submit students' Teacher Assessment Grades to the exam boards. During this process, there may be a need to request additional evidence from your child to support the submission of these grades.
